### 2019 Conference Key points

The conference is approved by WorkSafe under section 69 of the Act which means that **HSRs must be released on paid time** so long as you give your employer 14 days' notice. You have to negotiate with your employers to get Deputy HSRs released on paid time.

**Health & Safety Representative of 2018 was Daniel Gili, AMIEU HSR, Delegate and Vice President.**
