Don't give away meat workers conditions



Workers must stand together

Coles/Wesfarmer has made \$895,000,000 sheer profit out of supermarkets in the six months to December 2014.

But the SDA [Shop Distributive and Allied Employees Association] agrees with Coles that newly employed butchers who work Wednesday to Sunday should be paid \$12,500 less than the current similarly employed butchers; and new meat wrappers on the same shifts should be paid \$8,000 less every year.

The AMIEU says: One Job - One Rate.

The SDA are giving away the wages and conditions that meat workers have fought for and won through the AMIEU.

We believe that the SDA should fight for their members to achieve the penalty rates and conditions that the AMIEU won and are fighting to keep.

Currently Coles meat workers weekend rates - including penalties are: 175% on Saturdays; 200% on Sundays; and weekend work is voluntary not mandatory.

Ask the SDA why they think workers should get no penalties for compulsory work on Saturday and only 150% on Sundays. Ask the SDA why they are not fighting to take shop attendants' weekend rates up to ours, instead of selling out butchers, meat wrappers and cabinet attendants.

It is not too late - workers at Coles should Vote No for the proposed Enterprise Agreement - force them back to the table.
